

Catherine denies plastic surgery rumor




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Catherine Zeta-Jones' youthful looks spark controversy

Catherine Zeta-Jones looked remarkably youthful at a premiere on January 17, triggering plastic surgery rumors in Britain's *Daily Mail*. A spokesperson for the 36-year-old tells *In Touch* that there's no truth to the reports, but celebrity plastic surgeon Dr. Anthony Youn says the star shows telltale signs of cosmetic procedures, but not a face-lift. "The changes are pretty impressive," says Dr. Youn, who hasn't treated Catherine, but thinks that she may have had Botox, a lower eyelid-lift to get rid of bags, and fat transfers or fillers in her cheeks and smile lines. "Her face has gotten softer-looking and fuller, whereas most people's faces get thinner with age."

Rumors were rampant last April that Catherine's husband, Michael Douglas, 61, had gotten a face-lift, after shocking pictures revealed scars around his ears. Dr. Youn (who doesn't treat Michael) thinks the star did have the procedure.
