DID LARA GO TOO PLUMP?

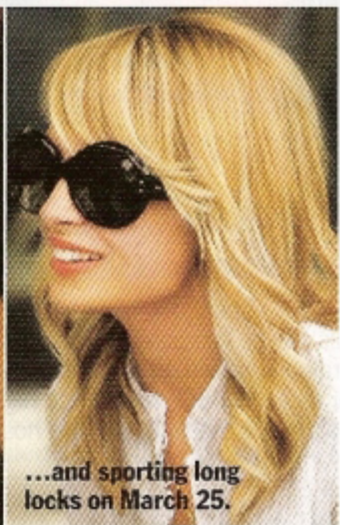
